According to an article by News 24, the average north american will take about 6.5 flights per year.



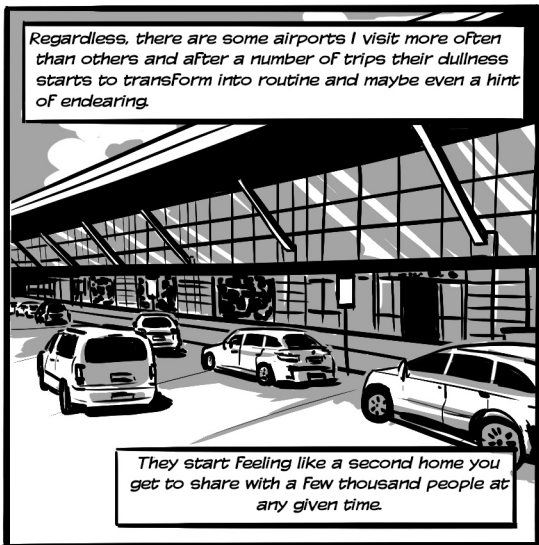
I fit somewhere in that statistic.
