






























































# Everybody Loves Smiley

The farm Mr. Thomas tends to with his wife Gladys has been in his family for generations.


The barn is old and decrepit, with a multitude of critters roaming about on its eaves and within its walls.

Odd sounds are commonplace in there: the chirp of a cricket, the hoot of an owl.


But one day, Mr. Thomas heard a sound unlike any other.














### **Afterword**
